

Who should study this qualification?

FE (Further Education)

CIH Level 2

- Those that want an introduction to the housing sector.
- Those that are new to working in the housing sector, irrespective of role
- Those who can commit to 16 weeks part time study

CIH Level 3

- Those that want to improve their understanding of the housing sector
- Those that want to learn skills and knowledge to improve their frontline job performance
- Those who have at least 6 months housing sector experience or existing CIH qualification
- Those who can commit to 9 months part time studying

CIH Level 4

- Those that want to gain a better understanding of the behaviours to be a more effective housing practitioner
- Those that want a better understanding of housing policy and housing law and how it complements housing practice
- Those board members keen to add to their housing knowledge
- Those with an existing housing qualification at CIH level 3 or recent academic qualifications or housing sector experience
- Those who can commit to 12 months part time studying

CIH Level 5

- Those that want a senior management role in a housing organisation
- Those that want to shape their organisation's working environment, culture and strategy
- Those with an existing housing qualification at CIH Level 4 and have reasonable experience in the housing sector or at senior level
- Those who can commit to 12 months part time studying
