### **General English Courses at five levels:**

**Entry requirements** – you will be invited to attend an information session to assess your level and help you decide on the most suitable course.

**Course fees** – £150 for 16 weeks. You will be required to pay course fees when you attend the information session, and you will not be accepted until payment has been received. You will also be expected to buy a coursebook.

### **Fee Waiver**

If you are a current FT student of D&A you may be eligible depending on class numbers. If you or your partner receive benefits, are eligible to claim benefits or are on a low income you may qualify. Please bring evidence of benefits with you to registry services evidence (dated within 2 months of the start date of the course). This also applies to au pairs who will need to bring in a letter from their employer.
